Resolutions

1. Adoption of the Remuneration Report

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass the following resolution as an **ordinary resolution**:

“That the Remuneration Report for the year ended 30 June 2018 be adopted.”

Note that the vote on this resolution is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

Voting Exclusion Statement

The Company will disregard any votes cast on the above resolution:

- by key management personnel or their closely related parties; or
- as a proxy by key management personnel or a closely related party of any key management personnel.

However, the Company need not disregard a vote if:

- it is cast by a person as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with the directions on the proxy form; or
- it is cast by the person chairing the meeting as proxy for a person who is entitled to vote, in accordance with a direction on the proxy form to vote as the proxy decides.

2. ELECTION OF ANTHONY JEFFERIES AS A DIRECTOR

“That Mr Anthony Jefferies, who was appointed by the Board as a Director on 23 March 2018 and in accordance with clause 6.1(e) of the Company’s Constitution being eligible, is elected as a Director of the Company.”

Representatives will be required to present documentary evidence of their appointment on the day of the meeting.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Explanatory Statement has been prepared to assist shareholders with their consideration of the resolutions detailed in the Notice of Annual General Meeting dated 24 October 2018. This Explanatory Statement should be read with, and forms part of, the accompanying Notice of Meeting.

1. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND REPORTS

As required by section 317 of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth), the Financial Report, Directors' Report, Directors' Declarations and the Independent Audit Report of the Company for the financial year ended 30 June 2018 will be laid before the Annual General Meeting. Shareholders will be provided with the opportunity to raise questions in relation to the reports; however there will be no formal resolution put to the meeting.

2. RESOLUTION 1 – ADOPTION OF THE REMUNERATION REPORT

2.1 Background

The *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) requires that listed companies include a remuneration report in their Directors' Report. The remuneration report is set out on pages 7 to 11 of the Company's Annual Report. The Remuneration Report includes information in respect of the Company's remuneration policies in respect of Directors and Group executives, including the relationship between remuneration policies and the Company's performance, prescribed details of Directors and Group executives, details of securities included in the remuneration of Directors and Group executives and details of persons employed under a contract.

The resolution to adopt the remuneration report has been put to the members in accordance with section 250R(2) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth). Any outcome, with respect to this resolution, is advisory only and does not bind the Directors or the Company.

The Chair will allow a reasonable opportunity at the meeting for shareholders as a whole to ask questions about or make comments on the Remuneration Report.

The Directors will consider the outcome of this vote and any comments made by shareholders on the Remuneration Report at the meeting when reviewing the Company's remuneration policies.

2.2 Voting exclusion statement

For the purposes of the voting exclusion statements on Resolution 1:

“key management personnel” (KMP) means those persons having authority and responsibility for planning, directing and controlling the activities of the Company, directly or indirectly, including any director (whether executive or otherwise) of the Company.

“closely related party” means: (a) a spouse or child of the KMP; (b) a child of the KMP's spouse; (c) a dependent of the KMP or the KMP spouse; (d) anyone else who is one of the KMP's family and may be expected to influence the KMP, or be influenced by the KMP, in the KMP's dealing with the Company; (e) a company the KMP controls; or (f) a person otherwise prescribed by the regulations.

Where the Chair is appointed as a proxy, the Chair will vote all undirected proxies in favour of Resolution 1.

If you appoint the Chair as your proxy, and you check the box consenting to the Chair voting undirected proxies, then unless you include an express voting direction on your proxy form, you will be directing, and expressly consenting to the Chair to vote in favour of Resolution 1.

3. RESOLUTION 2 – ELECTION OF ANTHONY JEFFERIES AS A DIRECTOR

Mr Anthony Jefferies was appointed by the Board as a Director on 23 March 2018. Under clause 6.1(e) of the Company's Constitution, Mr Jefferies may hold office until the next annual general meeting of the Company and is eligible for election as a Director by the Shareholders at this Annual General Meeting.

Mr Jefferies is a partner at Gillis Delaney law firm. Anthony's experience spans a broad range of commercial litigation work for individuals, corporate and financial institutions including disputes arising out of fraud investigations and general litigation; joint venture and shareholder disputes; initiating and defending claims for urgent injunctive relief; leasing and other property and construction litigation and insolvency disputes. He also represents clients in alternative dispute resolution such as mediations, expert determinations and arbitrations. He has represented both private individuals and publicly listed companies in a number of high-profile cases. Anthony has extensive experience in managing complex and sensitive disputes for both the public and private sectors.

4. RESOLUTION 3 – ELECTION OF LEE CHRISTENSEN AS A DIRECTOR

Mr Lee Christensen was appointed by the Board as a Director on 25 July 2018. Under clause 6.1(e) of the Company's Constitution, Mr Christensen may hold office until the next annual general meeting of the Company and is eligible for election as a Director by the Shareholders at this Annual General Meeting.

Mr Christensen is a director of CXlaw in Western Australia. Lee was previously the senior partner of Gadens/Dentons in Perth and has practiced law for over 30 years. He has experience in insolvency, finance, commercial and corporate law and regularly acts for both private and publicly listed companies.

5. RESOLUTION 3 – ELECTION OF MATTHEW WORNER AS A DIRECTOR

Mr Matthew Worner was appointed by the Board as a Director on 25 July 2018. Under clause 6.1(e) of the Company's Constitution, Mr Worner may hold office until the next annual general meeting of the Company and is eligible for election as a Director by the Shareholders at this Annual General Meeting.

Mr Worner is a corporate and commercial lawyer with over 17 years' experience. Matt has advised a number of Australian companies on matters such as IPO's, back door listings, secondary capital raisings, shareholder meetings, corporate governance and general commercial matters. Matt has held commercial, legal and company secretarial roles with several ASX and AIM listed Companies both in Australia and the United Kingdom, including Tap Oil Limited, Pura Vida Energy Limited and Otto Energy Limited.

Recommendation

The Directors unanimously recommend that Shareholders vote in favour of all the resolutions set out in this notice of meeting.
